

DECLARATION ON DAYCARE

Dear Parents,

I would like to inform you that - according to the Act CXC of 2011, 27 § (2) on National Public Education - in primary schools education should be organized between 8am and 4pm, and if it is necessary supervision should be provided for students until 5 pm. The purpose of the afternoon sessions is the preparation for the next school day and provide guided leisure activities. In case of absence the Rules of School Policy apply. In case of exceptional absence, please indicate it in the message booklet. In lower grades (1-4) the study time lasts from 14:30 to 15:30, during which – unless the parent has indicated in advance – we cannot let the students go home.

According to 55 § (1) CXC Act cited above, the School Director may release the students from the school sessions before 4pm in justified cases (training, special lessons, music school) at the prior request of the parents.

If the child is unable to attend after school sessions for compelling reasons, please submit a written request of exemption addressed to the Director. In case of exemption the students must complete their homework at home. If the exempted student's academic performance deteriorates or they do not regularly do their homework, the school may oblige them to attend the afternoon sessions. In the event of a disciplinary offence, the institution may exclude the 'guilty' student from the afternoon sessions.
